



Dr. K G Santhya is an outstanding economist and demographer, with over 15 years of experience in designing and conducting rigorous qualitative and quantitative studies on rights of youth, gender equity and women's empowerment, reproductive health and gender based violence. She is an associate at the Population Council's office in New Delhi, where she manages and conducts research on maternal health and young people's reproductive and sexual health issues. She holds a Ph.D. in population studies from Flinders University, Australia, and M.A. degrees in economics from the University of Kerala and in population studies from the International Institute for Population Sciences in Mumbai, India. She was the recipient of a postdoctoral fellowship from the Population Council. She has worked extensively with multiple stakeholders from the government, NGO and development sectors. She has authored several book chapters, peer-reviewed journal articles and study reports on child marriage, the needs of married adolescents, violence against women, maternal health, and youth sexual and reproductive health. She has been called upon to provide peer review to many international journals on health, education and youth. She has served as a member of various international panels, including the Asian Population Association Council, the Scientific Panel on Reproductive Health and the Scientific Panel on HIV/AIDS and Sexual Behaviour, International Union for the Scientific Study of Population.
